This event has been organised by CHE and a working committee of graduates for the benefit of all graduates. It will be non-profit making with ticket sales covering costs.

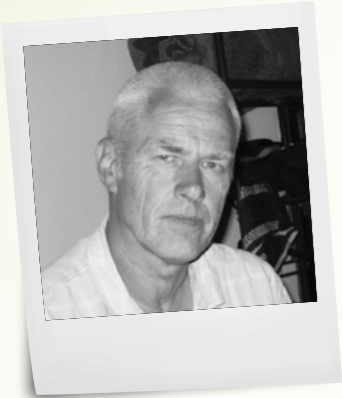
Our aims:

GRADUATE CONFERENCE 2011 - HEADLINE SPEAKERS

Bill Rumble



Bill Rumble has been teaching and practicing homeopathy for 25 years and founded the Welsh School of Homeopathy in 1995. "I believe the process of education should combine deep reflection, inspiration, exuberance and playfulness. I have lectured in Britain and Ireland since 1991."

"Pattern and process" decoding the Organon.

This talk describes the process of engaging with and recording the image of the disease.

Hahnemann tells us that recording the image of the disease is the most difficult work of all. Bill will explore the process by which the image of the disease can be recorded accurately and the remedy will demand attention.

Anna Watson - Founder of The Arnica Network,

(Patient Representative on the PCT, Shadow HealthWatch Steering Group Member Kingston, Breast Feeding Student Counsellor, Primary Teacher)

Anna Watson will share her positive and passionate journey from which a grass roots network of parents and holistic practitioners found each other. Now known as The Arnica Network. Not silent islands but thriving communities. She will explain how we as homeopaths can tap into the local energy and link with other health practitioners and potential clients, she will also discuss how homeopaths can forge a respected place in society and get alternative viewpoints on vaccination heard and respected. The Arnica Network helps those with alternative viewpoints feel less isolated in their decision-making when seeking natural alternatives to medicines.

Geoff Johnson



Geoff started homeopathy in '95 and quickly became passionate about it's exploration and practice. He studied for three years with the Homeopathic Practitioners Teaching Group in Oxford and became the 20th vet to achieve the VetMFHom. Since then he has studied extensively with many homeopaths, especially from the Bombay School, and has become a practitioner of the sensation method of homeopathy.

Seeing the nature within the patient

In his case taking with humans and animals Geoff tries to see nature within his patient. He will be covering a wide range of remedies from the natural world that illustrate his experience with both humans and animals.

Cases will reveal materia medica from bird, animal, mineral and plant kingdoms providing an exciting look at the sensation method in homeopathy.
